At **Relaxia Beverly Park** we continuously work to improve the impact we have on people and places.

Greenhouse Gas Emissions:

We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity. As part of this commitment, in 2025 we set the goal of reducing our GHG emissions from energy by 3% and those from water by 3% by the end of 2026. Regarding waste, we aim to reduce plastic bottle waste. As for water consumption, we did not achieve the reduction target because irrigation in common areas increased. We are studying planting species that require less water in our complex.

We know there is still work to do, and since 2025 we have been rolling out new initiatives across our operations to help us reach our 2026 target. We encourage our valued guests, employees and visitors to support us by following the reminders displayed throughout the hotel on saving water and energy and minimizing waste.

Biodiversity protection and community activity:

We are proud to be planting native Canary Island species in our gardens and green areas and signposting them with QR codes. With support from specialists within our group, we will also seek to plant species that require less water to help meet our water-reduction target.

Since 2024 we have focused on supporting a community project by collecting donations for Ciudad de San Juan de Dios (a centre for people with special needs). For 2025 our goal is to raise at least €800 across all complexes to support this work. If you would like to donate to this important community project, you will find a donation box at reception.
